I. SENIOR CAUCUS ACHIEVEMENTS IN THE PAST 2 YEARS

Together we have accomplished a tremendous amount of achievements most of which have never been done before:

- We Increased membership to almost three 3 times what it was when elected
- We are now able to determine who is member and when their membership is due
- We eliminated membership dues!
- We increased treasury
- We increased endorsements of candidates to over 50 candidates statewide
- We implemented successful GOTV efforts through multiple methods including over 10,000 statewide post cards to voters and in some districts improved voter turnout by highly increased percentages
- We moved to successful use of virtual meetings, eliminating the need to travel in bad weather or over long distances in MN
- We improved coordination of Chapter information & communication
- We enriched a credible social media presence through website, Facebook, monthly messages, and multiple email streams
- We delineated, improved, and increased committee involvement
- We improved our governance process
- We aligned with DFL party in multiple areas including Code of Conduct to remove bullying
- We improved attendance at all of our statewide events

 - Provide training to the Senior Caucus Board: Speakers on Roberts Rules of Order, Parliamentary procedure, speakers Ken Martin, Age Friendly MN, DFL Code of Conduct, David Schultz political speaker, and more
- C. Events
 - Developed an annual events strategic planning calendar: Day on the Hill, Annual Meeting, Summer Gathering, State Fair, Gala, potential fundraiser
 - Engaged in successful all virtual legislative Day on the Hill

 - Established a method and process for developing By-Laws

 - Managed the Senior Caucus Website and Facebook, posting messages, endorsements, monthly messages, speakers, topics of interest; monthly messages to our members
 - Created a process to maintain, membership maintenance, online, and behind the scenes
 - Improved Zoom technology use
 - Created virtual voting methods

 - Convened and/or formalized new and existing standing committees, Governance, Political Affairs, Membership, Technology, Communications, Book Club, Annual Events planning, Orientation, Recruitment, Executive Committee meetings to facilitate Senior Caucus endorsements
