Let's look at our US Constitution: The First Amendment of the United States Constitution protects the rights to freedom of religion, speech, the press, and assembly, as well as the right to petition the government. Key provisions of the First Amendment include:

- Freedom of Speech: Safeguards the right of individuals to express themselves without government interference.
- Freedom of the Press: Guarantees the freedom of the media to publish information without government censorship.
